The RCE is a transformative outdoor educational camp designed for Indigenous youth aged 14 to 18, set in the pristine wilderness of Northeast British Columbia. This four-day, three-night experience immerses youth in their heritage and the natural world through culturally based, hands-on activities that build skills and cultural knowledge while learning new ways to reconnect with Mother Nature.

- Cultural Medicine Gathering
- Hunting and Fishing Skills
- Meat Rack and Dry Meat Preparation
- Sweat Lodge Ceremonies
- Traditional Farm and Gardening Techniques
